Dan Strauss sole non-Chamber supported candidate to earn FUSE Progressive Voters Guide endorsement, is clear progressive choice in Seattle City Council District 6

Strauss also received the highest rating in District 6 from the Civic Alliance for a Progressive Economy (CAPE)

Seattle, WA - Dan Strauss, candidate for Seattle City Council District 6, has been endorsed by the FUSE Progressive Voters Guide and has received the highest rating in the district from the Civic Alliance for a Progressive Economy (CAPE), establishing him as the progressive choice in District 6.

Strauss is the only FUSE-endorsed candidate not endorsed by the Seattle Metropolitan Chamber of Commerce's PAC in District 6.

"I am thrilled and honored to have been endorsed by FUSE," said Strauss. "I have spent my life fighting for progressive principles, and I will continue that fight on the City Council.

"I am also proud to have received the highest rating in District 6 from CAPE. Their values—economic justice, racial equity, and affordability for everyone—are my values. I look forward to working on innovative policies and legislation to build a more just, more equitable Seattle."

Strauss adds support from CAPE and his endorsement from FUSE to endorsements from SEIU 1199NW, SEIU 925, UFCW 21, Machinists 751, Teamsters 117, UAW 4121, Seattle Subway, the Alliance for Gun Responsibility, the King County Democrats, the King County Young Democrats, and the Washington State High School Democrats. Strauss also has endorsements from Seattle City Councilmember Sally Bagshaw, Rep. Gael Tarleton, former State Rep. Jessyn Farrell, Snohomish County Executive Dave Somers, and many District 6 community leaders.
